### Forklift Training Guidelines

It is vital that all workplaces using forklifts have the checklist below or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety rules are being followed, each of these questions should be answered with a "yes". A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural flaw that could lead to injury, damage to machine or accident.

- 1) Is the forklift operating area separated from pedestrian traffic?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) The pedestrian walkways well-marked?
- 4) A sign is clearly visible stating a "lift truck in operation"?
- 5) There are mirrors provided at blind spots for pedestrians and operators?
- 6) Changes or alterations to the daily lift truck schedule has been communicated to employees?
- 7) Are lift truck tires suitable for use on all operating surfaces?
- 8) Lift truck seatbelt is being used?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Is an annual forklift certification and inspection carried out?
- 12) Is the type of forklift right for the job?
- 13) Does forklift has a load chart that is readable?
- 14) Do all operators know how to read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for various attachments and uses?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work properly?
- 17) Is the operating speed control device fitted right?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted right on the lift truck?
- 19) Do the operators of the lift truck have certifications to operate the equipment?
- 20) Warning signs and speed limits are being observed?
- 21) Are lift truck operators up to date on training for all types of lift trucks being utilized?
- 22) Do operators know their duties to report any machine damage and lift truck accidents?
- 23) Prior to the machine being utilized, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed each and every day?
