General Hazards

Common types of hazard in a warehouse setting are trips, falls and slips. These accidents are often caused when employees lose their balance or stumble over something which has not been put away properly. Removing or placing stuff from storage could lead to a fumble or slip, potentially causing both employee and item to fall. The potential for slips, trips and falls is increased when employees are moving things on different types of floor surfaces and on different levels. One more common hazard is getting hit by falling items. This is usually caused by failure to correctly stack stuff on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of incorrect lifting methods are one more common hazard.

There are inherent risks in using and working around workplace machines. Accidents can normally be caused from the improper utilization of forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks. Warehouse tools, like pallets, skids, cutting and strapping tools, should be used carefully in packing, unpacking and loading.

Hazardous substances, flammable or combustible materials can pose hazards while being stored in a warehouse. Staff should know how to take steps to protect themselves from health dangers while working around hazardous materials.
